DANIEL 9:1 - MATTHEW 26:56

1. As you read your Bible this week, which particular thought(s) and event(s) stood out to you or surprised you? What questions came up that you would like to find the answers to?
2. As you read through the “minor” prophets (called such because of the shortness of the books), which themes kept coming up? What did you learn about the character of God and Israel’s wrongdoing and future hope?
3. In what way have you benefited from reading the Old Testament?
4. The New Testament starts in Matthew by recounting the genealogy of Jesus. Did you recognize any of the names of the men who were Jesus’ ancestors? What is the significance of Jesus being a direct descendent of King David of Israel?
5. As he taught his disciples, Jesus repeatedly referred to or quoted Old Testament passages of scripture. Why do you think he did this?
6. When Jesus taught, he often emphasized the importance of the internal spiritual condition of people rather than mere outward obedience to the Jewish law and traditions. Why was this such an important truth for his Jewish audience to understand?
