HEBREWS 1:1 - REVELATION 22:21

1. As you read your Bible this week, which particular thought(s) and event(s) stood out to you or surprised you? What questions came up that you would like to find the answers to?
2. To what group of people was the Book of Hebrews written? With that in mind, what do you think the purpose of the Book of Hebrews was?
3. The Book of James covers a variety of topics. Which passage in James impacts you the most? Why? What seems to be the main idea of James? People say that the key verses of James are from Chapter 1, verses 22 – 25. Would you agree? Why? Were there any passages in James that were confusing to you?
4. The theme of 1 John is how to live-in-fellowship with God and with each other. What does it say in Chapter 1 is necessary to live-in-fellowship with God? What does this mean?
5. The Book of Revelation is a prophetic book that speaks about how God plans to wind up time and life on earth. What did you read that amazed you? What did you read that confused you?
