47 applications have been sent to foundations seeking **\$2.2 million** in support.

OUR \$10 MILLION GOAL REMAINS WITHIN REACH

At least **\$10 million is an attainable goal**,  according to forecasts based on Grace and Forge planning studies.

48 planning study participants who told us that they would support the campaign have yet to make their commitments.

60 leading Grace families who have the potential to give at least **\$1.6 million collectively have yet to make a commitment**. In all, Grace families had request amounts **totaling \$45 million**.

20 of Forge's top supporters - **who could potentially give \$400,000** - have yet to make a pledge. In all, Forge families were invited to consider \$1.7 million in support.

A LASTING IMPACT THROUGH LEGACY GIVING

ESTATE PLANNING - **including wills and trusts** - will provide future support for Grace & Forge programs and facilities. 

61 planning study respondents reported that they have included Grace in their estate plans. 

130 Grace and Forge families want information about estate planning to seek advice from their legal and financial advisors about how to formalize these legacy plans.
