

STUDY OPTIONS | FOR SMALL GROUP MEMBERS

Your group is free to study whatever topic is of interest to you. All we ask is that the studies you choose teach sound biblical principles. If you are unsure about a study or an author, please ask the Small Groups Director and they will be happy to make sure the study is reviewed by our Christian Education team before you start your study.

If you don't know what to study, we have a list of 2-years' worth of curriculum that your group can follow. You are also free to review this list and pick and choose studies that seem relevant to your group.

STUDY OPTIONS

- We have bookshelves of books and studies in the Small Groups office for you to use with your group, that you can borrow by checking them out. You can find a complete list of these resources on the Grace website under "Get Connected", "Small Groups," "Resources for Small Groups," "Small Group Studies and Books." Contact the Small Groups Director to schedule a time to look through the resources in person and checkout resources that you would like to borrow.
- Our church subscribes to the website studygateway.com, which allows groups to stream hundreds of bible studies directly to their media devices. A group login will be provided to the host of each group, upon request.
