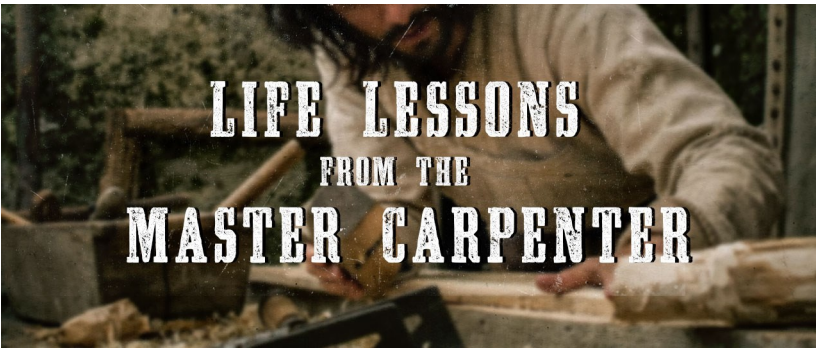
Ephesians 1:13-14 (NLT)
