Matthew 4:1-2 (NLT)

Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted there by the devil. For forty days and forty nights he fasted and became very hungry.

2 Causes of My Spiritual Wilderness:

1. God – He allows it for a season to build my faith.

Deuteronomy 2:7 (NLT)

Jesus' 5 Steps to Overcome Temptation:



Realize temptation often comes after our greatest victories.

Matthew 3:15-17 (NLT)

But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." So John agreed to baptize him. After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy."



Refocus on God's Word rather than the temptation.

Matthew 4:4 (NLT)

But Jesus told him, "No! The Scriptures say, 'People do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."

"What I resist, persists."

Temptation is always an opportunity to do the right thing.

2 Corinthians 10:5-6 (TPT)

We can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One. Since we are armed with such dynamic weaponry, we stand ready to punish any trace of rebellion, as soon as you choose complete obedience.

Temptation Always Follows a Predictable Pattern:

- It gets our <u>attention</u>
- It sparks our <u>arousal</u>
- It tricks us into action
- Refuse to let Satan define my identity.

Actively put space between myself and the temptation.


