





- 4. The tomb was discovered to be empty just a few days later.
- 5. The disciples had experiences they believed were literal appearances of the <u>risen</u> Jesus.
- 6. The disciples were transformed from doubters to proclaimers.
- This resurrection message was the <u>center</u> of preaching in the early church.
- This message was especially proclaimed in <u>Jerusalem</u>.
- 9. As a result of this preaching, the church was founded and grew.
- 10. Sunday became the day of worship.
- 11. <u>James</u>, brother of Jesus, a skeptic, was converted to the faith when he believed he saw the risen Jesus. *He was then* <u>executed</u> for his faith.
- Paul, a <u>persecutor</u> of Christianity, was also converted by an experience which he likewise believed to be an appearance of the resurrected Jesus.
