James 1:2-6 (NIV)

"Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. If any of you lacks wisdom he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind."

Rejoicing is not the power of positive thinking; it's the power of allowing the Holy Spirit to help you think positively in any situation.

Four Guarantees About My Problems:

- Problems are inevitable. "Whenever" not "If".
- Problems are unpredictable. "...whenever you face trials ..."
- Problems are innumerable. "...of many kinds..."
- **Problems are** <u>purposeful</u>. "...the testing of your faith produces perseverance..."

God's Purpose for Allowing Problems is to:

1. Purify my faith.
