3 Pictures from the Past:

- **Noah's baptism was a message about God's gracious deliverance—through his judgement.**

Genesis 6:8-9 (NIV)

But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD. This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God.

- **Moses' baptism was a message of salvation—through the sea—to new life.**

Hebrews 3:5 (NIV)

"Moses was faithful as a servant in all God's house," bearing witness to what would be spoken by God in the future.

- **Jonah's baptism was a message of resurrection—to a new life of obedience.**

Matthew 12:40-41 (NIV)

For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now something greater than Jonah is here.

Today's Baptisms Teach Us:



Obedience to Christ starts in the water.

Titus 3:5 (NIV)

Galatians 3:27 (NIV)

...for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

1 Peter 3:21 (GW)

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (NIV)
