The word for "yield to others" in the Greek is *eupelthes* which means "Allow discussion" or "Open to reason from others".

But keep watch over your own heart so that you won't be tempted to exalt yourself over him. Love empowers us to fulfill the law of the Anointed One as we carry each other's troubles. If you think you are somebody too important to stoop down to help another (when really you are not), you are living in deception.

The Five Steps from Galatians 6:

- Don't assume you know anything about anyone.
- Seek full and total <u>restoration</u> for those who have fallen in sin.
- Empathize with their hurts and never stand in judgment.
- <u>Humble</u> yourself.
- Do careful <u>self-examination</u> of your own life before helping someone else.
