What is causing the quarrels and fights among you? Don't they come from the evil desires at war within you? You want what you don't have, so you scheme and kill to get it. And even when you ask, you don't get it because your motives are all wrong—you want only what will give you pleasure.

Do you think the Scriptures have no meaning? They say that God is passionate that the spirit he has placed within us should be faithful to him. And he gives grace generously. As the Scriptures say,

So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Come close to God, and God will come close to you. 3 Causes of Conflict:

1. We love possessions more than people.

Verses 1b-2a (NLT)

Don't they come from the evil desires at war within you? You want what you don't have, so you scheme and kill to get it.

2. We want to control others.

Verse 2b (NLT)

You are jealous of what others have, but you can't get it, so you fight and wage war to take it away from them. Yet you don't have what you want because you don't ask God for it.

How we combat the temptation to control:

- We must pray constantly.
- We must declare war on selfishness.

Proverbs 13:10 (TPT)

Wisdom opens your heart to receive wise counsel, but pride closes your ears to advice and gives birth only to quarrels and strife.

3. We prefer pleasure over our passion for God.

Verses 3-5 (NLT)

And even when you ask, you don't get it because your motives are all wrong—you want only what will give you pleasure. You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God. Do you think the Scriptures have no meaning? They say that God is passionate that the spirit he has placed within us should be faithful to him.

What attitude is necessary for curing conflict? <u>Humble</u> myself before God.

Use psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to teach and instruct yourselves about God's kindness. Sing to God in your hearts. Everything you say or do should be done in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
