4 Keys to Being Unoffendable:

Realize anger is a sinful reaction, not a godly response.

Proverbs 16:32 (TPT)

Proverbs 15:1 (NLT)

9 Steps Toward Becoming Unoffendable:

- Examine my heart immediately.
- Assume the best about the person.
- Remember I don't have all the facts.
- Refuse to go to others in gossip or slander.
- Give grace to the offender, as if you were that person.
- Never be offended or angry at a nonbeliever.
- Seek to understand the reasons and motives for the offense.
- Pray for the person, consistently and compassionately.
- · Live peacefully, as much as it depends on me.
