Basic Instructions Before Leaving Earth

Romans 15:4, 13 (TPT)

Whatever was written beforehand is meant to instruct us in how to live. The Scriptures impart to us encouragement and inspiration so that we can live in hope and endure all things... Now may God, the fountain of hope, fill you to overflowing with uncontainable joy and perfect peace as you trust in him. And may the power of the Holy Spirit continually surround your life with his super-abundance until you radiate with hope!

2 Corinthians 5:17-18 (MSG)

Now we look inside, and what we see is that anyone united with the Messiah gets a fresh start, is created new. The old life is gone; a new life emerges! Look at it! All this comes from the God who settled the relationship between us and him, and then called us to settle our relationships with each other.

2 Timothy 1:9 (NLT)

For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus.

How we fulfill this mission:

The great commandment is a <u>non-negotiable</u> command for Christians.

Matthew 22:36-40 (NLT)

"Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" Jesus replied, "'You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

The great commission is not an option for Christians.

Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

We are here to bless God with our worship. (Glorify)

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart..." (Worship)

Ecclesiastes 3:11a (NLT)

Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time.

John 17:4a (NLT)

Revelation 4:11a (NCV)

"You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, because you made all things."

Worship is my <u>focused</u> response to God's infinite love.


Hosea 6:6 (TLB)

1 Corinthians 12:13 (TPT)

For by one Spirit we all were immersed and mingled into one single body. And no matter our status—whether we are Jews or non-Jews, oppressed or free—we are all privileged to drink deeply of the same Holy Spirit.

1 Peter 1:3 (TLB)

God has given us the privilege of being born again so that we are now members of God's own family.

Hebrews 2:11a (CEV)

Jesus and the people he makes holy all belong to the same family.

Fellowship is about giving to and receiving from God's family.

Romans 1:12 (NCV)

I mean that I want us to help each other with the faith we have. Your faith will help me, and my faith will help you.



We are here to become more like Jesus every day. (Act)

"Teaching them to do..." Mathew 28 (Discipleship)

Hebrews 12:2 (TPT)

We look away from the natural realm and we focus our attention and expectation onto Jesus who birthed faith within us and who leads us forward into faith's perfection. His example is this: Because his heart was focused on the joy of knowing that you would be his, he endured the agony of the cross and conquered its humiliation, and now sits exalted at the right hand of the throne of God!

Philippians 2:5 (NCV)

In your lives you must think and act like Christ Jesus.

2 Corinthians 3:18 (NLT)

So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

Discipleship is about God's ultimate goal for my life, which is Christ-like <u>character</u> rather than comfort and complacency.



We are here to use our <u>SHAPE</u> so we can serve and care for those in our church and community. (Care)

Psalm 139:13 (MSG)

...you shaped me first inside, then out; you formed me in my mother's womb.

"Love your neighbor as yourself." (Ministry)

Ephesians 2:10 (LB)

It is God himself who has made us what we are and given us new lives from Christ Jesus; and long ages ago he planned that we should spend these lives in helping others.

Romans 12:1-2 (MSG)

So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so welladjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.

Ministry is about using my time, my energy, my finances and my hurts to be a contributor rather than just another Christian consumer.



We are here for the distinct mission of sharing the Good News of Jesus with everyone as much as we possibly can. (Express)

"Go make disciples..." (Evangelism)

John 17:18 (MSG)

In the same way that you gave me a mission in the world, I give them a mission in the world.

Acts 20:24 (NCV)

I don't care about my own life. The most important thing is that I complete my mission, the work that the Lord Jesus gave me-to tell people the Good News about God's grace.

1 Thessalonians 1:8 (MSG)

The word has gotten around. Your lives are echoing the Master's Word, not only in the provinces but all over the place. The news of your faith in God is out. We don't even have to say anything anymore - you're the message!

Our evangelistic mission is the great privilege of telling everyone the Good News about Jesus and how He changed our lives.

Telling my story is about answering 4 questions:

- What was my life like before I met Jesus?
- How did I realize my need for Jesus?
- When and where did I put my <u>trust</u> in Jesus?
- What has Jesus done in my life since I made that <u>decision</u>?

Mark 16:15 (NCV)
