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3 Types of Peace Available to You:

<u>Spiritual</u> peace = Eternal peace with God <u>Emotional</u> peace = Internal peace with myself <u>Relational</u> peace = External peace with others

 Peace with God comes the moment I receive God's gift of salvation.

Isaiah 9:6-7a (NLT)

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Five ways to live in this peace:

- Receive God's forgiveness Confess my sinfulness and trust in Jesus as my Savior.
- Look at myself the way God looks at me love myself for who God made me to be.
- Never compare myself to others just let God improve the version of me He created.
- Accept people just the way they are stop trying to mold people into your image.
- Give God complete control of my life daily trust God without all the answers to my questions.
- Peace with myself comes continuously as I <u>surrender</u> my life to Christ daily.

Colossians 3:15a (NLT)

And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts.

God's Word gives <u>790</u> promises for peace in life's storms.
