WHAT YOU NEED:

"Story Book" Activity Page, found on main Explore KIDS ONLINE page. Option to print page or only download to view on mobile device. Crayons for coloring

WHAT YOU DO:

Download "Spy Book" Activity page and option to print the page. If printing, fold the copy to make a story book. Give each child a "Story Book" and have crayons available for coloring. As you review the Bible story with your family, encourage the child(ren) to color each story picture.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Today, we're going to make story books! Then, you can tell your friends about today's Bible story. Now, we can read the story together while you color the pictures.
